## Royal Tea



1. One shot of vodka (can also be gin or white rum)
2. One serving of Nicety Lemon (one part Nicety and five parts of water)
3. Ice
4. Mix all of the above in a cocktail shaker
5. Shake
6. Garnish with a lime wheel and serve

## Royal Beach Tea

1. One shot of vodka (can also be gin or white rum)
2. One serving of Nicety Mint (one part Nicety and five parts of water)
3. Ice
4. Mix all of the above in a cocktail shaker
5. Shake
6. Add a sprig of mint and serve



## Bee Tea








1. One spoon honey
2. One Serving Nicety Mint (one part Nicety and five parts of water)
3. Ice
4. One shot of vodka or gin
5. Mix in a cocktail shaker
6. Shake
7. Add a sprig of mint and serve

## Breezy Tea







1. One part Breezer – any flavor
2. One shot of vodka or gin
3. One Serving Nicety Lemon (one part Nicety and five parts of water)
4. Ice
5. Mix all in a cocktail mixer
6. Shake
7. Garnish with a lemon wheel and serve



## Arnie Palmer

-  1 A serving of Nicety Lemon (one part Nicety and five parts of water)
-  2 A shot of vodka or dry gin
-  3 Two teaspoons of honey
-  4 Pour Nicety and vodka or gin over ice in a martini shaker
-  5 Pour out over ice in a 16 ounce glass
-  6 Stir
-  7 Garnish with a slice of lemon

## Tea Soda

-  1 A portion of Nicety Lemon (concentrate)
-  2 A shot of vodka or dry gin
-  3 Sparkling water
-  4 Pour Nicety and vodka or gin into a glass over ice
-  5 Add sparkling water
-  6 Garnish with a slice of lemon

## Citrus Tea Cocktail

1. A serving of Nicety Mint (one part Nicety and five parts of water)
2. A shot of vodka or dry gin
3. Juice of one clementine
4. Two teaspoons of honey (or buckwheat honey for interesting variation in flavor)
5. One teaspoon of vanilla extract
6. Pour Nicety and vodka or gin into a martini shaker filled with ice
7. Add clementine juice, honey and vanilla extract
8. Shake and pour into a martini glass
9. Garnish with the rind of the clementine

## Gin and Tonic

1. Two portions of Nicety Lemon (concentrate)
2. A shot of Hendrick's Gin
3. Juice of a quarter of lemon
4. Tonic water (preferably naturally sweetened)
5. Freeze Nicety in an ice cube tray
6. Put Nicety ice cubes, Hendrick's Gin and lemon juice into a martini shaker
7. Shake and let it sit for five minutes
8. Pour mixture into a glass and add tonic water

## Boston Tea Hardy

1. A portion of Nicety Lemon or Mint (concentrate)
2. A shot of dry gin
3. A cup of extra dry vermouth (more if you like your drink sweet)
4. Fresh Basil or Clementine or a shaving of extra dark single-origin chocolate or halved frozen grapes for garnishing
5. Pour all of above into a martini shaker
6. Shake vigorously and pour into a martini glass
7. Garnish

1. A serving of Nicety Lemon (one part Nicety, five parts water)
2. A shot of dark rum
3. A cup of orange juice
4. Shake all with ice in a shaker
5. Pour into a tall glass with ice
6. Garnish with slice of orange and a sprig of mint
